Weekly Spotlight — Annual Conference — June 5-8, 2019

What is Annual Conference? Annual Conference is the yearly gathering of the churches of the Dakotas Conference of the UMC. About 180 churches send pastors and lay leadership to celebrate ministry, to make decisions on various issues, to recognize graduates and ordination of elders and deacons, and to set a vision for the upcoming year.

Who all goes to Annual Conference from Winner? All churches send the pastor(s) and one lay delegate per pastor. The conference also equalizes lay and clergy representation. Winner was awarded two extra lay delegates, based upon our church's size. Our lay delegates are Kristin Britt and Clint and DeAnn Woods.

What is it like at AC? There are three worship services and some great teaching — usually two sessions that focus on a specific topic. This year's topic is "reaching the next person for Jesus". The business portions include reports, petitions, awards, and vision setting.
